




### Itinerary

Stop 1

### Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa

- Your Tour Guide will pick you up from your Hotel in Cairo.
   And accompany you to visit the city of Alexandria. The drive will take about three hours to reach the city.
- You will start your day tour by visiting the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa which are the largest Roman Cemetery consisting of three levels cut in the rock. The lower level is totally submerged in the water, but the first two levels are still in a very good condition and represent a huge variety of tombs for the burials of the roman period in Alexandria.
   (60 minutes – Entrance fees not included)
- Second to that, you will pass by the Pompey's Pillar for a quick photo stop. It was constructed in honor of the roman emperor Diocletian at the end of the 4th century.

(15 minutes – No entrance fees)

Stop 2

### Roman Amphitheater and Library

• Then you will drive to visit the Roman Amphitheater of Alexandria with the display of the sunken monuments of Alexandria which were discovered under the East harbor of Alexandria.

(30 minutes – Entrance fees not included)

• Next stop is the library of Alexandria; the biggest library in the world. You will visit its open court where you can see the statue of Alexander the Great and the statue of Ptolemy the first, which was found underwater nearby. You will visit president Saddat Museum and impressions of Alexandria Museum.

Alexandria library is closed on Fridays, Saturdays & in public holidays.

To enter the reading area the and library's manuscripts museum, you will need to purchase a ticket. (Optional).

## Itinerdry Stop3 Citadel

 After finishing this visit, you will stop at one of the local restaurants to enjoy a fresh sea food meal as the town is the most famous for sea food restaurants, offering the biggest and most delicious variety around all of Egypt.

(60 minutes – meal price not included)

• After enjoying your lunch meal, you will drive across from the old harbor to the far west side of the city to visit Quaitbay castle which was built on Pharos peninsula on the same site as the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria. One of the seven wonders of ancient world that got totally destroyed by an earthquake in 1375 A.D. The citadel was established by Sultan Al-Ashraf Quaitbay, one of the most well-known Mamloukies who ruled Egypt in 1477 and was later fortified and equipped with cannons by Sultan Qunsua Al Ghoury to defend the city against the Ottomans' invasions.

Stop 4

### Montaza gardens

• Finally, you will visit the royal gardens of King Farouk (the last king in the history of Egypt) known as Al Montazah Gardens and see the royal palaces of Haramlek and Salamlek as well as the royal beaches of the queens.

(30 minutes - Entrance fees not included)

 On your way back you will stop over the famous bridge of Stanley – the modern landmark of modern Alexandria for a quick photo stop and after, you will drive back to Cairo and dropped at your hotel.

#### Tour
