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Itinerary

Day 1

Cairo

- Our tour agent will meet and assist you (either at Cairo Airport, Train Station, or hotel) to be transferred to your 4-stars hotel near the pyramids to check in.
- Overnight in Cairo

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Itinerary

Day 2

Alexandria

- Your tour Guide will pick you up from your Hotel in Cairo after having breakfast at 07:00 am and accompany you to visit the city of Alexandria. The drive will take about 3 hours to reach the city. You will start your day tour by visiting the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa which are the largest Roman Cemetery consisting of three levels cut in the rock. (60 mns – Entrance fees not included)
- Then, you will pass by the Pompey's Pillar for a quick photo stop. (15 mns – No entrance fees)
- After that, visit the Roman Amphitheater of Alexandria with the display of the sunken monuments of Alexandria. (60 mns – Entrance fees not included)
- Next stop is the library of Alexandria; the biggest library in the world. You will visit its open court where you can see the statue of Alexander the Great and the statue of Ptolemy the first. You will visit president Saddat Museum and impressions of Alexandria Museum.

(Alexandria library is closed on Fridays, Saturdays & in public holidays. And to enter the reading area and library's manuscripts museum, you will need to purchase a ticket). (60 mns – Entrance fees not included)

- After enjoying your lunch meal, you will drive across from the old harbor to the far west side of the city to visit Quaitbay castle which was built on Pharos peninsula on the same site as the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria. One of the seven wonders of ancient world that got totally destroyed by an earthquake in 1375 A.D. (60 mns – Entrance fees not included)
- On your way back you will stop over the famous bridge of Stanley – the modern landmark of modern Alexandria for a quick photo stop and after, you will drive back to Cairo and dropped at your hotel to enjoy dinner and overnight.

Overnight in Cairo – Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

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Itinerary

Day 3

Giza Pyramids, Museum, Islamic Cairo

- The tour starts at 08:00 am. You will be met by our tour guide in the lobby of your hotel in Cairo. Then, you will be transferred to the **Pyramids of Giza**.
- You will see the pyramids and the Great Sphinx and learn everything about this amazing place. (You can add extra tickets allowing you to enter the inside of the great Pyramid of Giza). (180 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- You will be transferred to visit the Egyptian Museum of antiquities in Tahrir. (120 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- After that, you will be transferred to visit The Citadel of Cairo, where is the famous alabaster Mosque of *Mohamed Ali Pasha*, and the ruins of the Citadel. (60 minutes – Entrance tickets not included) And finally you will have some time off to discover the famous soukKhan El Khalili.
- After Finishing the tour, you will be transferred to Cairo bus station where you will be met by the tour agent who will accompany you to check you in to the bus you use to go to Aswan.

Overnight in the bus to Aswan – Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.



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Day 4

Philae

- Starting with visiting the High Dam; achieved in 1960's to form the biggest man-made reservoir in the world (Lake Nasser) and generate 10% of the total power grid in the country. (30 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- Back to Aswan where you will stop for Lunch at one of the local restaurants and proceed on with the visit in Philae Temple, the Greco Roman Temple dedicated to goddess Isis, goddess of love and magic. (As the temple is located on an island, you will use a small motorboat to get to/come back from the temple). (90 mns – Entrance tickets not included – motorboat not included)
- Later, return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Overnight in Aswan – Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

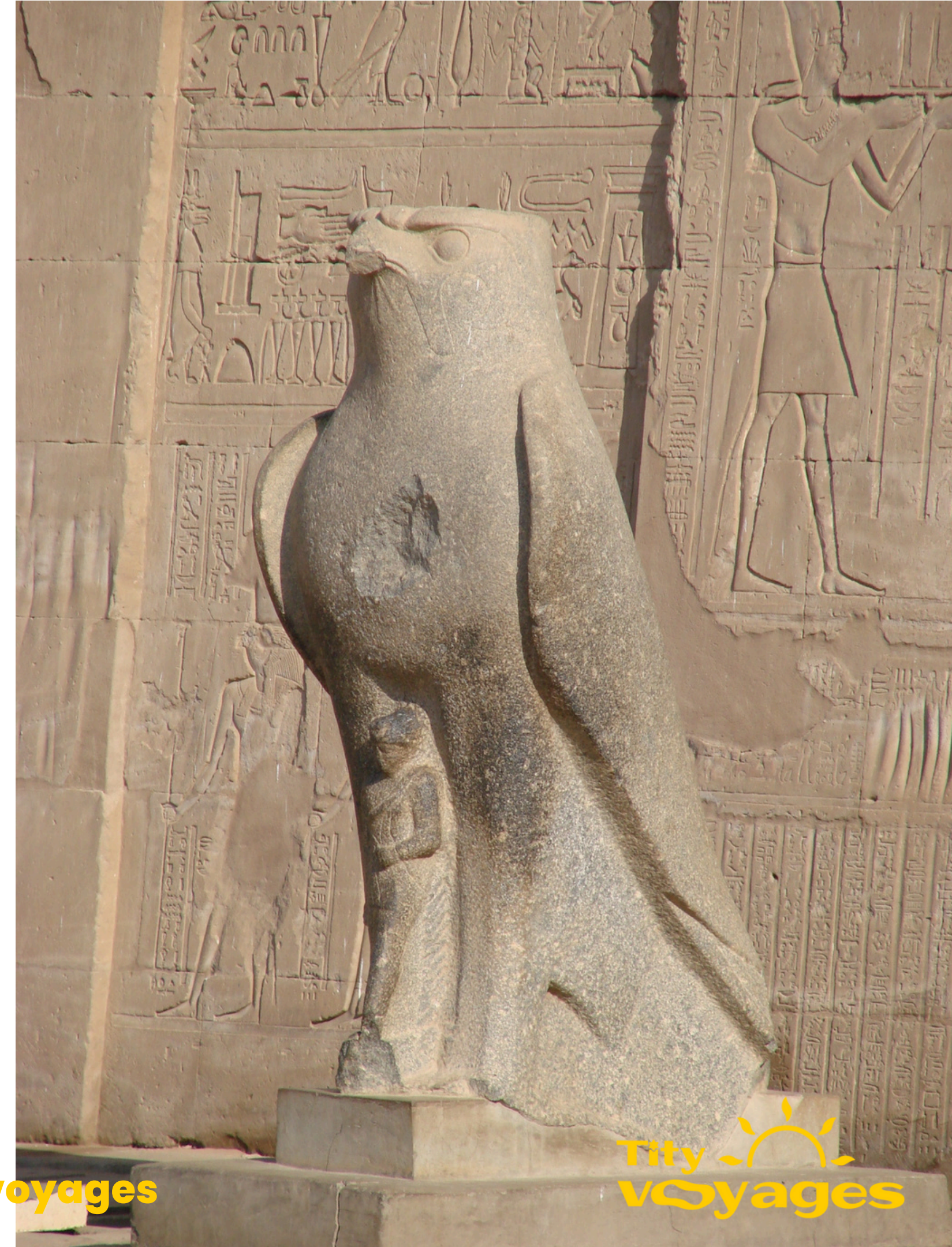


Itinerary

Day 5

Kom Ombo and Edfu

- On the morning, enjoy your breakfast at the hotel and checkout to start your day driving towards Luxor while visiting temples on the way. You will have your lunch as a lunch box from the hotel in Aswan as the drive and visits will continue till after lunch time. You will drive for about an hour before arriving at the first stop, which is to the famous twin temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile God and Horus, the falcon God.
- After that, you will proceed the drive towards the second stop, Edfu Temple, dedicated to God Horus the Falcon. It is the most complete and the best-preserved temple among all other Egyptian temples. Discovered in 1860's by Auguste Mariette the brilliant French Egyptologist and first director of Antiquities.
- Once done with the temple, you will continue to drive towards Luxor, you will arrive there by the afternoon. You will check in to the hotel in Luxor and you can rest for the remaining time till dinner time at the hotel and overnight.

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Day 6

Balloon ride, Luxor West Bank

- Early start for the **Hot Air Balloon** ride as pickup is around 04:00 am (depending on the sunrise). You will be transferred to the **Colossi of Memnon** to start the tour. (20 minutes – No entrance tickets)
- Then, the **Valley of the Kings**, to visit 3 tombs among the open ones, using the standard ticket. You can purchase extra tickets for tombs of Tutankhamen, Ramesses VI, and Seti I. (120 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- **Hatshepsut Temple**, the only female King and first feminist in ancient history. (60 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- Visit to the **Alabaster Gallery**. (30 minutes – No entrance tickets). Lunch time in a local restaurant (Extra). Then, cross back to the east bank using a motorboat.
- Lunch time in a local restaurant. Then, you will be transferred back to the east bank to the hotel, and you can rest for the remaining part of the day. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



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Overnight in Luxor – Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

Itinerary

Day 7

Karnak and Luxor

- On the morning, you will visit Karnak Temples, the largest temple in Egypt and second largest in the whole world. (90 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- Then, you will visit Luxor temple on the East bank of Luxor. (90 minutes – Entrance tickets not included).
- After Finishing the tour, you will stop at one of the local restaurants for lunch meal and then you will be transferred to Luxor bus station where you will be met by the tour agent who will accompany you to check you in to the bus you use to go to Cairo.
- Checkout in Luxor – Meals: Breakfast, and Lunch.

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What you should know before booking

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Tour

This tour includes lots of site visiting and early wakeups. so, prepare yourself for an adventure but you will have as well some relaxing time.

You will be informed about all details of the program by the escorting tour guide of Tity Voyages on daily basis either in person or via WhatsApp message.

The order of visits may change but all visits will be made.

Pickups/Drop-offs

Pickups and drop-offs are from/to the airports/train station/hotels.

We can arrange the transfers and the flight or train tickets in Cairo with extra cost.

Shopping

Shopping is part of the experience, and we encourage you to buy stuff you would like to have to remind you with your trip.

But you must handle the price as salesmen always double (or sometimes even triple) the actual value of their products.

For the best deal you can have, we recommend you consult with your tour guide to guarantee fair price and good quality.



Internet

Most cruises/hotel have Wi-Fi service for an extra charge. But we don't recommend buying it from the cruise as it doesn't give you access except in the lobby and a very weak signal during sailing times.

It is widely recommended to buy a local SIM card from one of the local operators (Orange – Vodafone – Etisalat) and install it in your phone. It will be much cheaper than the cruise Wi-Fi and will grant you access at all times.

Tipping

Tipping is a customary thing in Egypt. The tipping required is for :

Crew members onboard the cruise. You can tip them on the last day by an envelope given to reception desk (average is 200 EGP per person per night)

The second category is drivers, agents, and tour guides (average is 400 EGP per person per day) and to be given directly to the person by the end of the service.

Kids

Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Child rate applies only when sharing with 2 paying adults. Infants must seat on laps during transportation and tours, but the cruise can supply infant seats while onboard.

Children between the age of 6 to 11 years old can share with parents the same cabin but with the maximum number of 2 children in one room.

Hot Air Balloon

Kids below the age of 6 years old are not allowed on the hot air balloon ride. Also, in case of the cancellation of the hot air balloon ride due to bad weather, security reasons, ... etc., you will be refunded by 25\$ per person.

In addition to, the professional cameras are not allowed on the hot air balloon while flying, you can only use the cell phone for photos and videos.

Medical conditions

Clients with medical conditions are not advised to do this tour as it requires a lot of effort, long drives, and early wake ups.

In case of suffering any serious medical condition, please inform us in detail. Most places visited on this tour are not equipped with wheelchair access.

The insurance provided along with this tour is against driving accidents only. Covering both injuries and death cases. No insurance provided against any medical problems or fatal conditions.

Cancellation

For a full refund, you must cancel at least 24 hours before the experience's start time.

Any changes made less than 24 hours will not be accepted.

And cut-off times are based on the experience's local time.
