

Itinerdry stop1 Gizeh

- The tour starts at 08:00 am. You will be met by our tour guide in the lobby of your hotel in Cairo. Then, you will be transferred to the **Pyramids of Giza**.
- Visiting The **Great Pyramid of Giza** first, also known as the Pyramid of Khufu or the Pyramid of Cheops is the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza pyramid complex bordering present-day Giza in Greater Cairo. It is the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the only one to remain largely intact. The complex consists of a valley temple, now buried beneath the village of *Nazlet el-Samman*, Causeway connecting the valley temple to the mortuary temple & the Pyramid structure itself.
- Moving on to Khafre's Pyramid complex consisting of the same elements of the great Pyramid in addition to the Sphinx. The valley temple yielded several statues of *King Khafre*. Several were found in a very good condition in the the temple by *Auguste Mariette* in 1860's and now exhibited in the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir.

- Third is the Menkaure's Pyramid complex consisting of the same elements of the other two. The valley temple once contained several statues of Menkaure, also exhibited now in the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir. During the 5th Dynasty, a smaller ante-temple was added on to the valley temple.
- Finally, the **Great Sphinx**, commonly referred to as the Sphinx of Giza or just the Sphinx, is a limestone statue of a reclining sphinx, a mythical creature with the body of a lion and the head of a human. Facing directly from West to East. The face of the Sphinx is generally believed to represent *King Khafre*. The original shape of the Sphinx has been restored with layers of blocks and is commonly believed to have been built during the reign of the *King Khafre* (c. 2558–2532 BC).
- (You can add extra tickets allowing you to enter the inside of the great Pyramid of Giza).


Itinerdry stop2 Saqqarah

- After finishing, you will be transferred to Saqqarah plateau located 27 km southwest of Cairo. Sakkara is a vast ancient burial ground served as the necropolis for the capital,
 Memphis, and features numerous pyramids for 17 Kings, in addition to a huge number of private funeral monuments of high officials and other members of the royal families. You will be visiting the Step Pyramid of Djoser.
- Established, designed, and built for the king by his brilliant vizier Imhotep. It is considered an incredible step in the evolution of Burials in Ancient Egypt, and the link between the simple mastaba to the widely known form, the pyramids. The complex is the oldest complete stone building known in history.

Itinerdry stop 3 Memphis

- Later, you will be transferred to visit the oldest capital in Egypt, Memphis, where you will see the colossal statue of King Ramesses II and the great Alabaster Sphinx. This is considered one of the oldest known cities in the world as it dates back to 3100 B.C.
- (30 minutes Entrance tickets not included)
- After Finishing the tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel.
