





Departure on Sunday or Tuesday or Thursday.



Your Boat

All cruises are categorized as 5 stars. But there is a different categorization to them based on : quality & variety of food, size of cabins, service, and sailing time. You can find :

- 5 stars Standard. (3 stars european standard)
 - 5 stars Deluxe. 4 stars european standard)
 - 5 stars Luxury. (5 stars european standard)

Accommodation is full board. All meals are included, not the drinks. All drinks are extra (even water). You can order anything and pay all the extras at once upon checkout.

The standard sized cabin is good for two adults with their luggage, or for two adults and a child. Generally, we don't recommend a triple room for three adults as it will be tight. Each cabin is equipped with a private bath with shower cabins, safe box, wide screen windows, air-condition, protection and smoke detector, daily housekeeping service, and laundry service upon request.

Day 1

Nubian Village

- Our tour agent will meet and assist you (Aswan Airport, Train Station, or hotel) to be transferred to your hotel at the nubian village for your lunch.
- Then you will visit the village and enjoy some relaxing time by the Nile and you can also shop at the traditionnal market.

Overnight at the nubian village - Meals: Lunch / Diner.


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Day 2

Aswan

- Our tour agent will meet and assist you to be transferred to your 5-star Deluxe Nile Cruise to check in before lunch.
- After having lunch on board, you will start your tour in Aswan by visiting the High Dam. (30 minutes – Entrance tickets not included)
- Proceed to visit Philae Temple, the Greco Roman Temple dedicated to goddess Isis, goddess of love and magic. (As the temple is located on an island, you will use a small motorboat to get to/come back from the temple). (90 minutes – Entrance tickets and motor boat not included)
- Later, return to the cruise for dinner, and overnight in Aswan.

Itinerary

Day 3

Abu Simbel and Kom Ombo

- Early Morning start aound 04:30 am, your guide will pick you up for Abu Simbel trip (4 hours drive each way) to visit one of the most impressive places in Egypt. The rock-cut temples of Abu Simbel with their unique design built for King Ramesses II and his beloved Queen Nefertari. (120 minutes Entrance tickets not included)
- Back to the Cruise by early afternoon to have your lunch and start sailing towards Kom-Ombo city to visit the only dual temple of ancient Egypt dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile God and Horus, the falcon God. (90 minutes Entrance tickets not included)
- Back to the cruise. Enjoy having dinner while sailing to Edfu for overnight. Overnight in Edfu.




Itinerary

Day 4

Edfu or Esna and Luxor

- Start in the morning before breakfast to visit **Edfu Temple** dedicated to God Horus the Falcon. (you will be transported to / come back from the temple using Horse- driven Carriages, or Vans & busses, depending on the availability). (90 minutes Entrance tickets and transportation not included)
- The second option is to visit Esna temple, dedicated to God Khnum.
 (60 minutes Entrance tickets not included)
- Return to the cruise for breakfast and sailing towards Luxor after passing Esna Lock. Lunch on board. Afternoon tea on sundeck.
- By late afternoon, the cruise will be docking in Luxor. Then, you will visit Luxor temple on the East bank of Luxor. (90 minutes Entrance tickets not included). If your arrival at Luxor dock by 3:00 or 3:30 pm, you will visit as well Karnak Temples.
- Return to the cruise for dinner and enjoy the Oriental Show (Belly dancer & Whirling Dervish shows). Overnight onboard in Luxor.


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
Day5

Luxor West Bank and Karnak

- You will be transferred to the Colossi of Memnon to start the tour.(20 minutes No entrance tickets)
- Then, the Valley of the Kings, to visit 3 tombs among the open ones, using the standard ticket. You will visit as well Tutankhamen tomb. You can purchase extra tickets for tombs of Ramesses VI, and Seti I. (120 minutes Entrance tickets not included except the Tutankhamen tomb which is included)
- Hatshepsut Temple, the only female King and first feminist in ancient history. (60 minutes Entrance tickets not included)
- Visit to the Alabaster Gallery. (30 minutes No entrance tickets). Lunch time in a local restaurant (Extra). Then, cross back to the east bank using a motorboat.
- Karnak Temples, the largest temple in Egypt and second largest in the whole world. (90 minutes Entrance tickets not included)
- Finally, you will collect your bags and be transferred to the drop off of your choice within the east side of the city of Luxor.







What you should know before booking



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Tour

This tour is a compact package. It includes lots of site visiting and early wakeups. so, prepare yourself for an adventure as this is not the relaxing type of a tour.

You will be informed about all details of the program by the escorting tour guide of Tity Voyages on daily basis either in person or via WhatsApp message.

The order of visits may change but all visits will be made.

Pickups/Drop-offs

Pickups and drop-offs are from/to the hotels on the East side of the city (either Aswan or Luxor).

Any pickups or drop-offs on the other side are extra and to be organized before the day of the tour.

Shopping

Shopping is part of the experience, and we encourage you to buy stuff you would like to have to remind you with your trip.

But you must handle the price as salesmen always double (or sometimes even triple) the actual value of their products.

For the best deal you can have, we recommend you consult with your tour guide to guarantee fair price and good quality.

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Internet

Most cruises have Wi-Fi
service for an extra charge.
But we don't recommend
buying it from the cruise as
it doesn't give you access
except in the lobby and a
very weak signal during
sailing times.

It is widely recommended to buy a local SIM card from one of the local operators (Orange – Vodafone – Etisalat) and install it in your phone. It will be much cheaper than the cruise Wi-Fi and will grant you access at all times.

Tipping

Tipping is a customary thing in Egypt.

The tipping required is for :

Crew members onboard the cruise. You can tip them on the last day by an envelope given to reception desk (average is 200 EGP per person per night)

The second category is drivers, agents, and tour guides (average is 400 EGP per person per day) and to be given directly to the person by the end of the service.

Kids

Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Child rate applies only when sharing with 2 paying adults. Infants must seat on laps during transportation and tours, but the cruise can supply infant seats while onboard.

of 6 to 11 years old can share with parents the same cabin but with the maximum number of 2 children in one room.



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Valley of the Kings

You will visit 3 tombs in the Valley of the Kings with the standard ticket (non included) and the Tutankhamen tomb (ticket included)

You are allowed to take pictures and vidéos inside the tombs, without flash.

Medical conditions

Clients with medical conditions are not advised to do this tour as it requires a lot of effort, long drives, and early wake ups. In case of suffering any serious medical condition, please inform us in detail. Most places visited on this tour are not equipped with wheelchair access. The insurance provided along with this tour is against driving accidents only. Covering both injuries and death cases. No insurance provided against any medical problems or fatal conditions.

Cancellation

For a full refund, you must cancel at least 24 hours before the experience's start time.

Any changes made less than 24 hours will not be accepted.

And cut-off times are based on the experience's local time.



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
